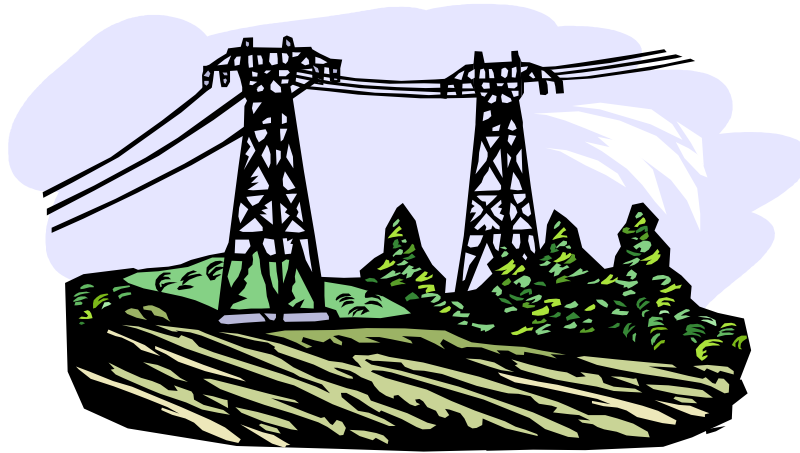


Join Art Schnure, author of Sherborn Walks, for a spring walk through
